COVID-19 Procedures

We at JTDC, are dedicated to maintaining the highest level of safety while offering competitions. Your compliance with these guidelines is necessary for the safety of everyone in attendance. If you feel that either 1) your safety is at risk, or 2) you cannot comply with these guidelines, please do not enter this show.

Note: Per AKC, the Trial Secretary is NOT responsible for incorrect or missing Information on the entry form. The Trial Secretary will try to obtain missing information, but it is not his/her responsibility. Any information must be sent in WRITING through regular mail or in an Email. Incorrect class entries may be corrected by the secretary.

COVID 19 Affirmation and Waiver:

By signing the entry form, I affirm that to the best of my knowledge I am COVID-19 free.

I also agree to refrain from coming to Trials and competitions at Jupiter Tequesta Dog Club (JTDC), and to notify JTDC, should my condition change. Further, I agree to follow club procedures and guidelines, precautions, and requirements, described in this premium list, to mitigate the possibility of spreading COVID-19. I understand the risks of contracting or being exposed to COVID-19 associated with my attendance at competitions and trials at JTDC, and I knowingly accept those risks.

I agree to waive, release, and hold harmless the Jupiter Tequesta Dog Club including its members, judges, and volunteers, required to host the competition, and its Board of Directors, from any claim or liability related to COVID-19.

COVID-19 free means that within the past 14 days I have not experienced the symptoms of COVID-19, (fever, coughing, shortness of breath). Also, I am not waiting for test results. If I have tested positively in the past, I have now been released to resume normal activity. In addition, I believe that I have not been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

Regular, Preferred, & Optional Titling Classes: Entry fee for these classes shall be \$28.00 per dog for the FIRST entry and **\$18.00** per dog, for each additional entry of the SAME DOG, SAME TRIAL. UDX Class: \$44.00.

All refunds will be issued after the closing date of the trial. Bitches that come into season will receive a refund minus \$5.00 per trial. However, you must notify the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the show of your withdrawal. If the trial has not closed, a full refund will be given. No vet letter is required.

Overnight deliveries must be sent with no signature required at delivery. Entry fees include a \$4.50 event service fee paid to AKC.

Electronic, telephone, or unsigned entries **CANNOT BE ACCEPTED**. Entries must be presented on an official entry form including the signature page on the reverse side. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee; or, the Trials cannot be held or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, flood, disaster, Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other case beyond the control of the Jupiter Tequesta Dog Club (JTDC). Full refund can be requested prior to the trial closing date and request must be made in writing (email is acceptable). If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, and the event secretary is notified no later than on half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the entry fee will be refunded, minus a processing fee of \$5 per dog, per day. The Trial Committee will convene as a result of any damage to hotel, motel, trial premises or on complaints of maintaining the cleanliness of the facility and the grounds or hotels. JTDC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, visitors, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for the injury to children. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parents or guardian. They must exercise control and restraint over their children at all times. Any and all damages caused by the exhibitor, exhibitor's dogs or children will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

THE CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM FOR THESE EVENTS.

Dogs may arrive prior to their scheduled times of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog not present at the designated class time. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when the dogs are called to be judged.

1. Enter dog's AKC recognized breed. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally Trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog" and enter ILP or PAL registration number."Breeder, Sire and Dam" information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
2. Variety. If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
3. Consult the classification in this Premium list for Classes Offered. This space may be used to indicate Obedience or Rally Class and the next section for Division (A/B). Consult the rules regarding qualifications for A or B divisions. If entering RAE (adv and exc) or HTQ (adv, exc, mst), please enter B Division. RAE and HTQ fees remain one full entry and reduced entry for second and third class entry of the same dog.
